III. President:

Consideration of Agreement with International Downtown Association for a fee of \$15,000 plus lodging and meals, for Advisory Panel related to operations and organization of the HB Downtown Business Improvement District.

Summary of Item:

Discussion and direction regarding the overall assessment of the Downtown Business Improvement District (BID) which will focus on the BID's structure, governance, programming and service delivery. The assessment would be conducted by the International Downtown Association (IDA) Panel Advisory Service, which will include leading experts in the downtown industry. The panel will provide direct and objective opinions regarding best practices and they have no vested interests in Huntington Beach. (Attachment Letter)

Recommended Action: It is recommended that the Board of Directors:

- i. Authorize the BID President to enter into an Agreement with the IDA for \$15,000 and to provide airfare, hotel rooms, meeting rooms and meals,
- ii. Authorize the BID President and Vice President to work with the City Council Liaisons and City staff to refine the request and initiate the assessment.
- b. Adjust the annual budget to include the above fees.
